

# **Instructions for NEET MDS- 2021 Uttarakhand State **extended**** **Mop-Up Round of Centralized Counselling (MDS Courses)**

## **1. Eligibility:**

- (a) All interested eligible candidates will have to register afresh by online mode only as per extended Mop-Up schedule to become eligible for Extended Mop-Up Round counseling.
- (b) Candidates who will not register (online) will not be eligible and/or considered for Extended Mop-Up round.
- (c) All the candidates who have qualified the NEET MDS 2021 examination are eligible to participate in the Mop-up round of counselling.

The following category of candidates are not permitted to participate in Mop-Up round:

- Candidates who are already admitted to MDS course through I<sup>st</sup>, II<sup>nd</sup> & Mop-Up Round of NEET MDS-2021 Uttarakhand State Centralized Counseling **are not eligible to apply for Extended Mop-Up round.**
- The candidates who have taken admission and retained their seats in various colleges in India under All India Government quota seats/Deemed Universities after second and mop-UP round of All India Counselling will **not be eligible** for Mop-Up round as per the Govt. of India/MOH&FW/Hon'ble Supreme court (writ petition civil no. 267/2017 dated 09/05/2017 direction no.4 and MCC).

## **2. Procedure:**

- (a) Extended Mop-up round will be conducted by online mode only.
- (b) All the candidates (including those registered for round I, II & Mop-Up) have to register for Extended mop-up round of counselling by payment of registration fees of Rs. 2,000/-
- (c) The Registration is to be paid by online mode only ( NET-banking/ Debit card/ Credit card)

## **3. Security Fees:**

- (a) All the new candidates have to deposit the security deposit as per information uploaded on university website as separate link.
- (b) Candidates who have already deposited security amount in previous round and if deposited security amount was not forfeited, need not to be deposit security fee again.

## **4- Document Upload/Details:**

- (a) Already registered candidates need not to their documents details again, but they must fill their online choices for Extended MOP UP round after depositing the required registration fee for Extended MOP UP round.
- (b) After depositing the required registration & security fee candidate have to fill their required details and filled their choices for Extended Mop-Up round. These choices are only valid for Extended MOP UP round.
- (c) The candidate who has fill his/her documents details in the previous round of

counselling are hereby advised to check their category/sub category certificates/ documents again for validity as only the valid original documents will be accepted during Extended Mop-Up round.

- (d) OBC Candidates are advised to check his/her OBC certificate carefully and ensure that it is valid, because the OBC certificate is valid for three years duration only from date of issue. The OBC certificate should be valid on the date of admission for session 2021-22 that is 19.11.2021 or at the time of counselling and admission in the concerned college/Institute- Claim of candidates for reservation with invalid OBC certificate will be summarily rejected during the counselling and he/she will be considered as un-reserved candidate only.

#### **5- Choice Filling:**

Candidates are required to fill fresh choices for Extended Mop-Up round of seat allotment as per Seat Matrix uploaded on the website. Choices of round I ,II & Mop-Up will not be considered for seat allotment.

Candidate must fill choice carefully as once submitted choice cannot be changed/edited later under any circumstance.

These choices are only valid for Extended MOP UP round.

#### **6- Allotment:**

Allotment on available State quota seats and All India-Management quota seats will be done by the Counselling Board purely on the basis of NEET MDS-2021 State merit list of Extended Mop Up round of the eligible candidates and choices filled by the candidates.

#### **7- Admission:**

- (a) It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to contact and collect all the information beforehand regarding various admission formalities of the concerned college of their choice.
- (b) Candidate has to complete remaining admission formalities at the college level by 19-11-2021.

#### **8- Conversion of Seats:**

Seat available for allotment in mop –up round will be offered to candidate of same category.

If any State quota seats remain vacant due to non availability of interested eligible registered candidates of their respective categories, then these vacant seats will be converted as per existing rules during Extended Mop-Up round seat allotment process. (Please read the information brochure for detail.)

In private colleges If the candidates are not available for state quota seat, the said seat will be offered to candidates eligible under management quota.

#### **9- General Conditions:**

- (a) The Counselling Board/University will not be responsible for any mistake committed on the part of candidates during counselling process.

- (b) No request for extension of last date of admission will be entertained in view of guidelines of DCI / Hon'ble Supreme court.
- (c) All the rules and regulations are subject to change as per the directions of the Hon'ble Courts/ Govt. of India/MCI/DCI/Govt. of Uttarakhand guidelines.
- (d) Candidates are advised to visit the university website regularly for any updates.
