

NEET PG-2017 Uttarakhand State Centralised Counselling

Instructions for Online Mop-up Round of Counselling

- **Mop-Up round of counselling will be held only on online basis.**
- **There will be no more counselling as it is the final Mop-up round of counselling. No more seat allotment will be done after this Mop-up round of counselling i.e. 30th May 2017.**
- In compliance to the order No. V.12025/181/2016-DE, Government of India (MOH&FW) dated 11.05.2017 and National Board of Examinations Notice dated 15.05.2017 and the order no. V.12025/18/2017-MEP, Government of India (MOH&FW) dated 24th May 2017, New/Fresh registration for MD/MS/PG Diploma/MDS courses are invited for online Mop-up round of counselling only.
- Only interested eligible registered candidates are eligible for NEET PG-2017 Uttarakhand State Centralised Counselling- Mop-up Round (Online).
- Newly registered eligible candidates are allowed to participate for Mop-Up round of Online counselling.
- The interested, eligible and registered candidates who were not allotted any seats in the 1st and 2nd rounds of counselling are eligible for Mop-up round of counselling.
- All candidates who have taken admission against seat allotted in 1st and 2nd rounds are also eligible for seat/college/quota up-gradation in Mop-up round of online counselling.
- **Candidates who have not taken admission against the 1st and 2nd rounds of allotment or have withdrawn after taking admission will not be permitted to appear in Mop-up round of counselling.**
- No extra fee will be charged for Mop-up round of counselling from already registered candidates.
- **All interested eligible registered candidates will have to fill New/Fresh choices to become eligible for Mop-up round of counselling otherwise they will not be eligible for Mop-up round of online counselling.**
- Candidates can choose New Quota, colleges, subjects as per his/her eligibility. Please refer information bulletin for eligibility.
- Allotment on available state quota seats, management quota seats and seats transferred from Central Quota (only for state quota candidates) for NEET PG-2017 Uttarakhand State Mop-up Round of Online Centralised Counselling will be done purely on the basis of NEET PG -2017 merit-cum-preferences of the interested eligible registered candidates.

- Vacant Seats transferred from Institutions will be filled under the same category candidate. If seats remain vacant due to non availability of eligible interested registered candidates of their respective categories, then these vacant seats will be converted in the Mop-up round of counselling as per rules. Please refer the information bulletin for details.
- Candidates are required to upload following self attested documents at the time of choice filling for Mop-up round of counselling; if not uploaded in 1st/2nd round of counselling or any other new document in support of their candidature.
 - High School (10th)
 - MBBS/BDS Degree Provisional/Permanent
 - Internship Completion certificate
 - Registration with State Medical/Dental council/MCI/DCI
 - Certificate of Reserve category, if applicable
 - Certificate of Sub Category, if applicable
 - NOC from competent authority for PMHS Uttarakhand candidates /candidate working in any other department of any states/central government/PSU, etc.
 - Required working certificate issued by the competent authority for P.M.H.S. Uttarakhand candidates only, interested for P.G. Diploma seats (reserved for P.M.H.S. Uttarakhand candidates only) of Medical Colleges of Uttarakhand and/or Government Medical Colleges of Uttar Pradesh.  - NOC from competent authority for the student serving under Bond
 - Domicile Certificate (Uttarakhand candidates only), if required.
- In service candidates (PMHS Uttarakhand candidates/candidates working in any other departments of any states/central Government of India/PSU, etc) will have to produce relieving certificate issued by competent authority at the time of joining the course.
- Candidates are advised to select the choices for Mop-up round of counselling for seat upgradation very carefully. If candidate is not interested in any specific subject/specialization/college/quota, it is advised not to opt for that specific subject/specialization/college/quota in choice filling process.
- If the candidate gets the allotment against the new choice, the seat allotted in the 1st or 2nd rounds will be automatically cancelled and allotted to next eligible candidate. The Counselling board/University will not be responsible for any mistake done by the candidates during choice filling.
- If the candidate does not get the allotment against the new choice, the seat allotted in the 1st or 2nd rounds will be retained by the candidate.

- Candidates must keep a printout of choices filled by him/her, for future reference.
- **All the interested eligible candidates are advised to fill the choices as many as per their choices as seats shown filled or reserved for particular category may be vacated by candidates due to upgradation or seat conversion or non confirmation of admission at the allotted college upto 27th May, 2017.**
- These choices will be valid only for Mop-up round of counseling.
- The candidate will not be able to change their order of preferences after final locking of choices. After this, the choices given by him/her will be finally locked by the Counselling board/University and **will not be changed under any circumstances. Hence candidates are advised to be careful during final locking of their choices.**
- The allotment letter will be available to the candidate along with necessary instructions through the University website. The printout of this allotment letter will have to be produced by the candidate at the time of admission to the college allotted to him/her. **No extension of last date of admission (i.e. 31st May 2017) will be permitted as it is decided as per the MCI/DCI/Hon'ble Supreme court guidelines.**
- Candidates who have been allotted the seat have to report to the concerned college with all original documents for verification as well as the required fee for confirmation of admission.
- Regarding refund of deposited admission fee please refer to the rules and regulation mentioned in the “**Information Bulletin- NEET PG 2017**”.
- **All the rules and regulations may change as per the directions of the Hon'ble Court issued from time to time.**
- **The counselling board reserves the right to modify the Mop-Up round schedule or terms and conditions of counseling.**
- **In-service candidates and candidates already under bond for compulsory service in Uttarakhand have to fulfil the conditions mentioned in the bond or as specified by State Government, DGH&FW, Uttarakhand and Hon'ble High Court from time to time. The Counselling board/University will not be responsible for any legal issues arising out of matter related with such bond or service conditions.**
- **In-service candidates of other states/central government/PSU, etc will also have to fulfil the conditions mentioned in their bond or as specified by their service rules.**
