

Instructions for NEET PG-2018 Uttarakhand State Extended Mop-Up Round of Centralized Counselling (MD/MS/MDS Courses)

1. In Compliance to the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in writ petition no. 556/2018 and Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand in writ petition no. 1495/2018, 1471/2018, the extended mop-up round of counseling will be held on 30.05.2018 and 31.05.2018.
2. Only interested eligible registered candidates are eligible for NEET PG-2018 Uttarakhand State Extended Mop-Up Round of Centralized Counselling.
3. The interested and eligible candidates who are already registered but not allotted any seats in any round of counselling are eligible for Extended Mop-Up Round of counselling.
4. Candidates who have withdrawn their seats after taking admission against any round of allotment will **not be permitted** to appear in the Extended Mop-Up Round of counselling.
5. All Candidates who have not taken admission against seat allotted in any round will **not be eligible** for Extended Mop-Up Round of counselling. (Except Hon'ble Court directions for specific petitioners.)
6. The candidates who have taken admission against any seat in any medical college of India are not eligible for Extended Mop-Up Round of counselling.
7. No extra fee will be charged for Extended Mop-Up Round of counseling for already registered candidates.
8. Candidates will have to produce the duly Notarized English translated version of their documents at the time of counseling & admission, if the documents are in languages other than Hindi or English.
9. Procedure & Guide Lines for Extended Mop-Up:

- a. All registered interested eligible candidates will have to **report (online)** as per Extended Mop-Up schedule to become eligible for Extended Mop-Up Round counseling.
- b. Candidates who will not report (online) themselves will not be eligible and/or considered for Extended Mop-Up round.
- c. All interested eligible candidates who have reported online will have to report in person on the day of manual Extended Mop-Up counseling for seat allotment i.e. 31st May, 2018 as per schedule at **Govt. Doon Medical College, Dehradun**. The candidates who will not report in person for Extended Mop-Up Round on 31st May, 2018 will not be eligible for seat allotment in Extended Mop-Up Round.
- d. All registered interested eligible reported candidates will have to download the **“Document Verification Form for Extended Mop-Up Round”** available in the link of university website.
- e. This form is to be duly filled by the candidates (only Part I) and submitted in duplicates at the Reporting Desk, Counselling venue.
- f. Candidates must bring all the original documents mentioned in the above format Part-II along with one set of self attested photocopies of the same in the sequence given in **“Reporting & Document Verification Form for Extended Mop-Up round”**. These original documents will be required on the date of seat allotment of Extended Mop-Up Round i.e. 31-05-2018.
- g. Already registered candidates are not required to upload new documents.
- h. Only valid original documents will be accepted during Extended Mop-Up round.
- i. The candidate has to report in person on the date of allotment and on the spot admission (31-05-2018) of Extended Mop-Up round. **No representative (including parents or guardians) will be allowed to participate in the counselling process under any circumstances.**

- j. Allotment on available State quota seats and All India-Management quota seats will be done by the Counselling Board purely on the basis of NEET PG-2018 merit list of the eligible candidates who have reported in person on the day of Extended Mop-Up Counselling and as per the on-the-spot preference opted by the candidate in front of the counseling board. **Mere registering & on-line reporting for extended mop –up round will not make a candidate eligible for seat allotment in extended mop- up round.**
- k. It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to contact and collect all the information beforehand regarding **various admission formalities** of the concerned college of their choice.
- l. Seat allotment will be done only after verification and collection of valid Demand Draft/Cheque in favour of “Finance Controller, H.N.B. Uttarakhand Medical Education University Dehradun” payable at Dehradun **as notified in the University website in a separate link.**
- m. **Without the required demand draft/cheque no seats will be allotted to any candidate. No extra time will be given for fee deposition.**
- n. So, all the candidate are advised to bring required demand draft/cheque on 31-05-2018. **No cash will be acceptable.**
- o. The candidate will collect their admission letter and receipt from the concerned college counter after deposition of original documents.
- p. If any reported candidate failed to report himself/herself before the counseling board when called for seat allotment according to his/her merit then the board will allot the seat to the next eligible candidate in order of merit. In such cases, if the candidate reports later on in front of the board, he/she will only be considered for the seats available at that time. **Hence, it will be the sole responsibility of the candidate to remain alert and report for counselling on time.**

10. Candidates and their parents are advised not to carry money in cash in the counselling venue. Counselling authority will not be responsible for any loss or theft in the counselling venue.
11. **The subjects of fee fixation of private Medical colleges of Uttarakhand are sub judice before the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand. The fee structure of private Medical colleges of Uttarakhand are subject to the final outcome of various writ petitions pending at the Hon'ble High Court of Uttarakhand/Hon'ble Supreme court of India.**
12. Counselling will continue till the last vacant seat is allotted and may continue up to late hours, candidates are advised to make their own arrangements accordingly.
13. No request for extension of last date of admission will be permitted as it has been decided as per the MCI/DCI/ Hon'ble Supreme court guidelines.
14. **Candidates will be allotted seats on merit basis on personal appearance before the counselling board, if any unauthorized person makes such promise or claims that he/she can assure you a PG Medical/Dental seat such cases must be brought to the notice of counselling board and police immediately.**

16. **All the rules and regulations are subject to change as per the directions of the Hon'ble Courts/ Govt. of India/MCI/DCI/Govt. of Uttarakhand guidelines.**
